Obituary for Melvin Louis Dallas, III


Senior Airman Melvin Louis Dallas, III, affectionately known as "Buddy" was born on Monday, January 11, 1993 at 0736, to Melvin and Karen Dallas in Jacksonville, Florida. On February 13, 2000, he was baptized at Northside Church of Christ. In May 2011, Buddy graduated from Jean Ribault Senior High School's, Early College Program where he earned his Associates of Arts Degree.

On Sunday, February 22, 2015 Buddy was called home to be with the LORD. During his teens, he played baseball for many years with Normandy Athletic Association and football with Westside Athletic Association. Growing up Buddy matured into a dedicated team member. He was always there for his family and friends in his personal life. His core values that he developed at home, on the playground and on the field translated to a very successful military career.
