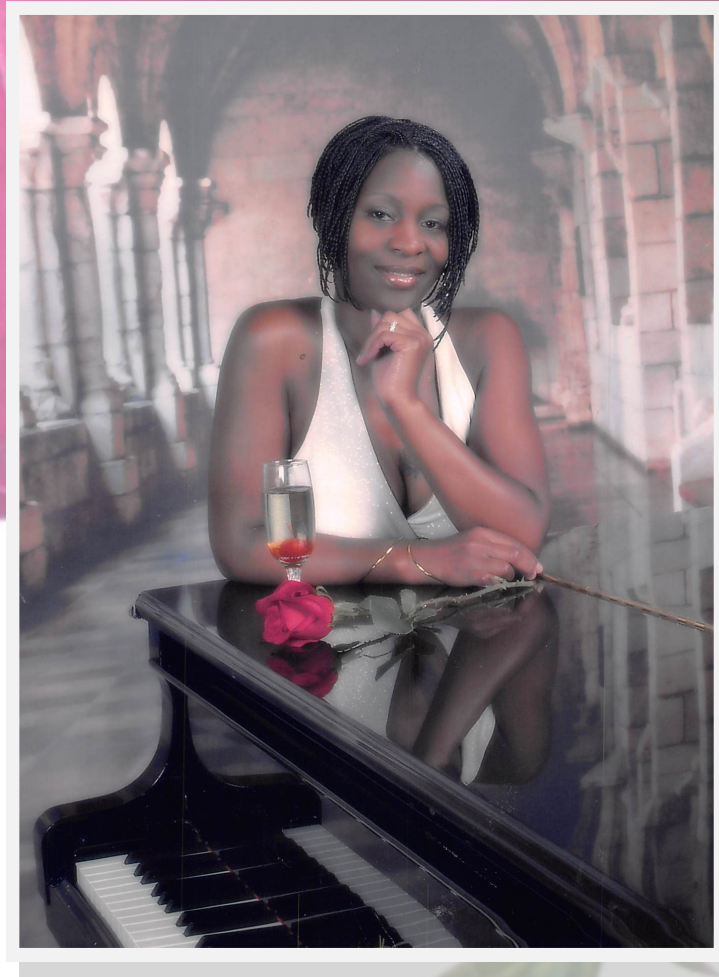

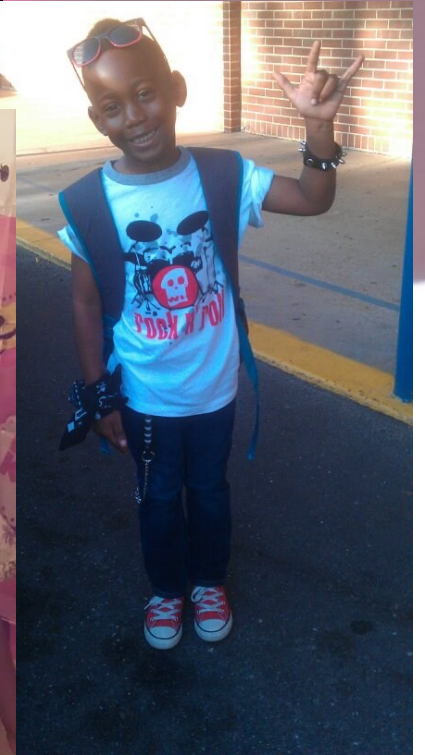
Mom

And so I want to thank you, Mom, and tell you lovingly, you are the best thing life has given to me!



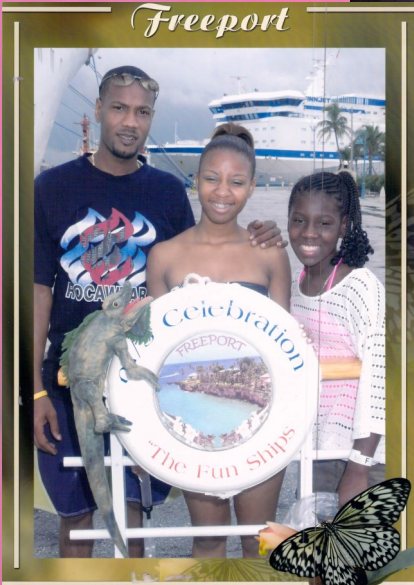
