Joyce continued her education by attending Albany State College in Albany, Georgia and received her BSN in

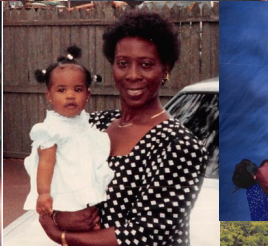
