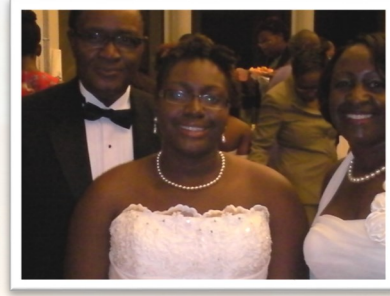
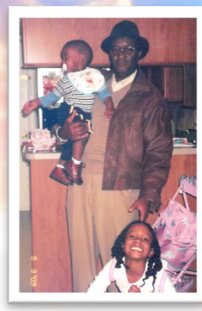
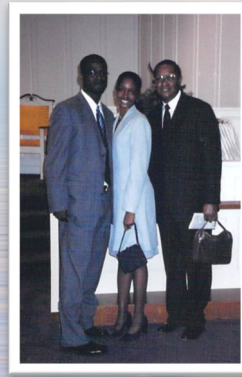
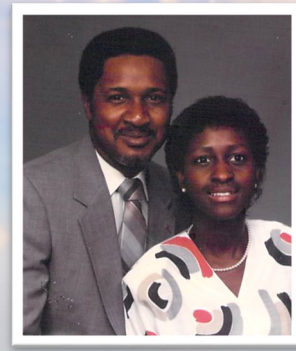
Obituary
