# Obituary

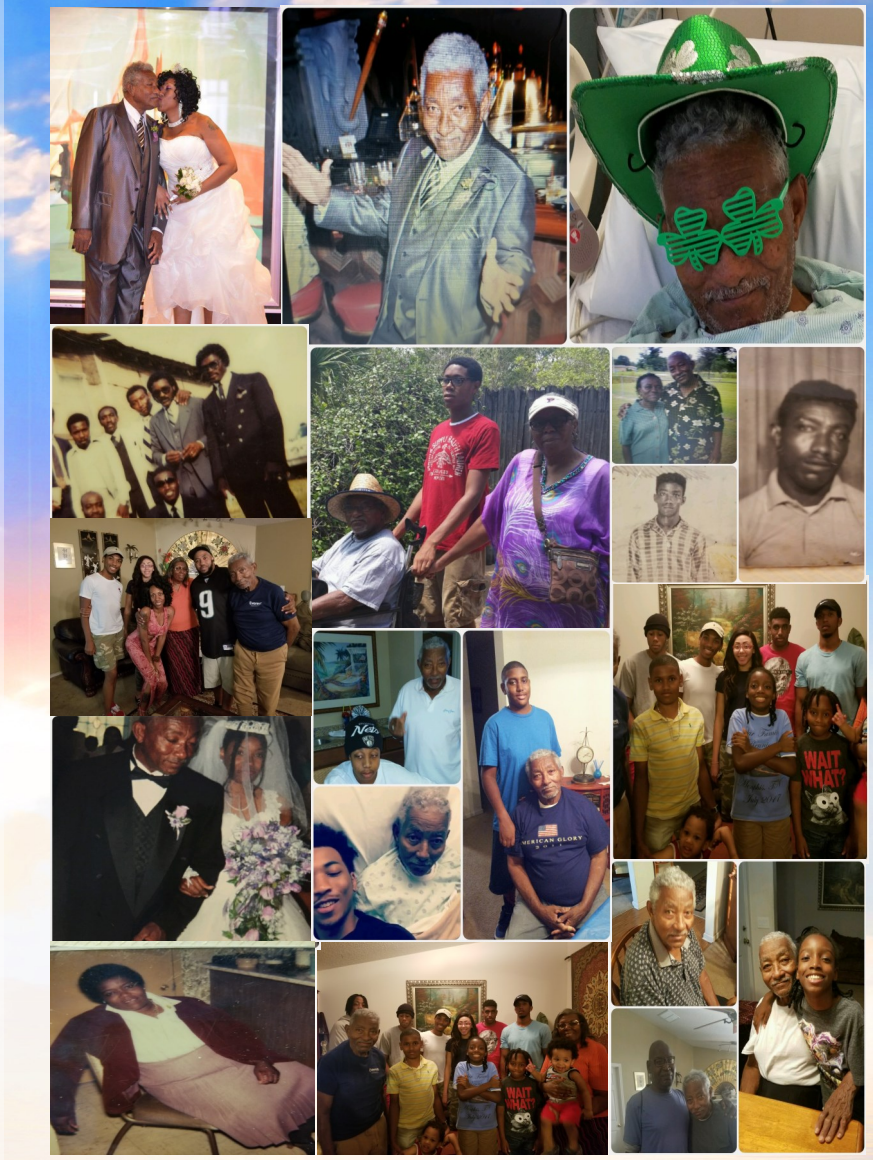
