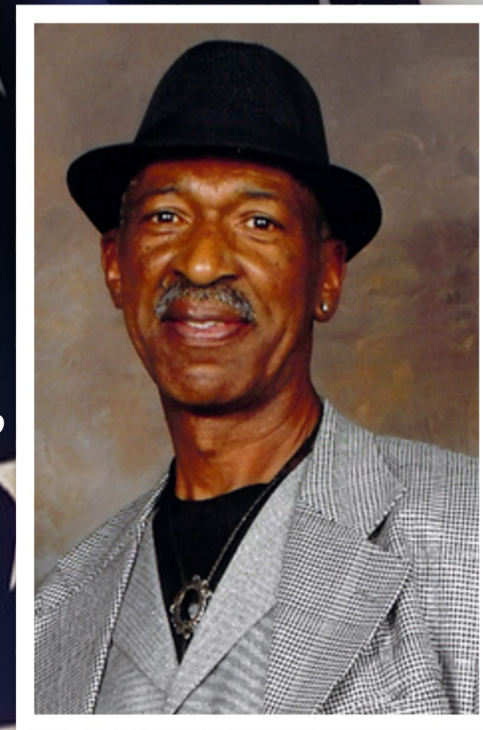

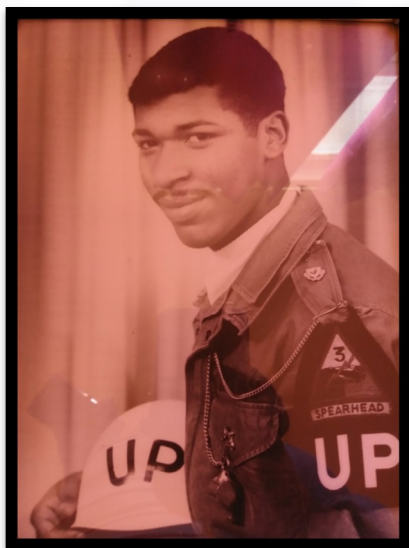
# Obituary
