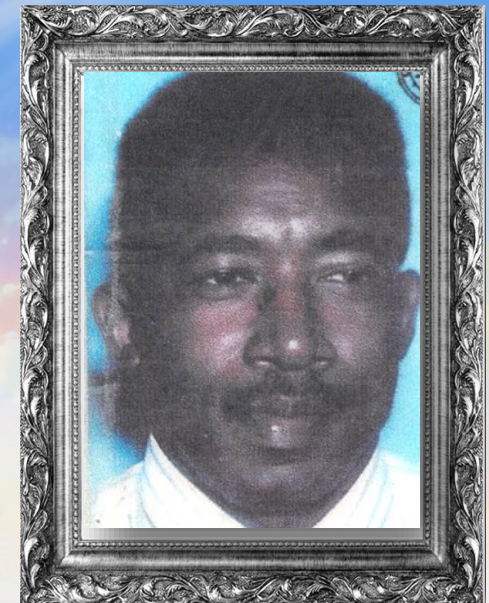

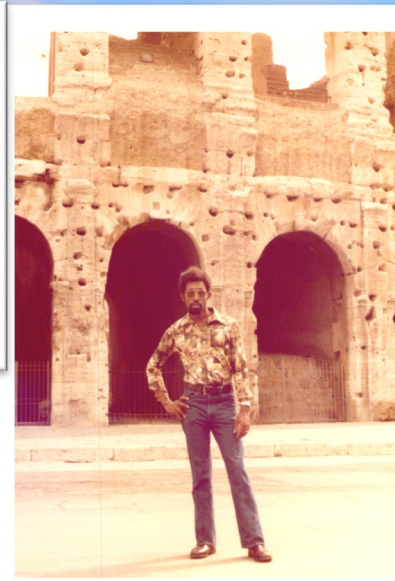
Benjamin decided to go into the United States Navy at an early age, making it a career of 22 years. Benjamin met Lauretta Lesene and they were married in October of 2004.
