**A Mother's love:** Is a sanctuary, where our souls can find sweet rest from the struggle and tension of life's fast and futile questions.

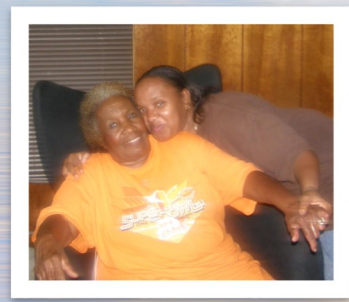
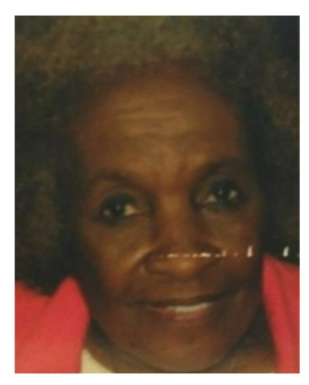
**A Mother's love:** Is like a tower, rising far above the crowd and her smile is like the sunshine, breaking through a threatening cloud.
