Jokisha "Dynasty" Brown was born on July 2, 1980 in Jacksonville, Florida at University Hospital, today known as Shands Medical. She is the oldest daughter of Cynthia Jones and the late Joe Brown. Jokisha graduated from Jean Ribault Senior High School. After graduating she worked several jobs on the Southside area of Jacksonville, which eventually gained her notoriety and popularity throughout the city and many other parts of Florida. As a model and actress, Jokisha flourished and found early success and became known as "Dynasty" to most people in her inner circle. As the years went by, Jokisha continued to grow and eventually outgrew Jacksonville and it's parameters, so in 2010, she decided to further her career and expand her brand by moving to Atlanta. 
