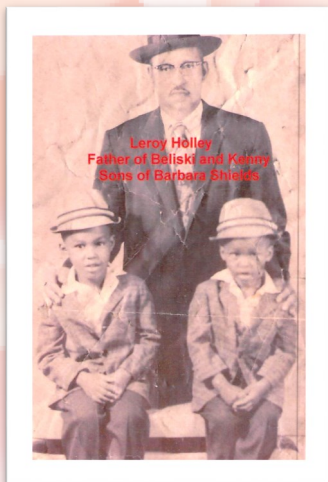
In Loving Memory of Barbara Jean Alexander Shields
