

Obituary



Dr. Dwight Edward Brisbane, Sr. was born in Jacksonville, Florida on September 21, 1949 to Mr. Christopher and Mrs. Flora Brisbane and Mr. Dwight Edward Bell. Dr. Brisbane was educated in the local schools and graduated from Stanton Vocational High School. He also attended the Job Corp, soon after graduating from the Job Corp he was drafted into the United States Marine Corps. He served a tour of duty in Vietnam. He enlisted into the United States Army and served another tour of duty in Vietnam. After retiring from the military, Dr. Brisbane worked for the United States Postal Service for ten years and retired.

On September 13, 1970 he was joined in holy matrimony to Sandra Jean King, to this union twelve children were born.

Dr. Brisbane confessed Christ as his savior in 1976 and attended Greater Holy Temple COGIN under the leadership of Bishop C.D. Kinsey. He was ordained as an Elder and installed as a Pastor. He served as a Pastor for a total of 35 years. He pastored Olustee COGIC, Victory Temple COGIC, and Higher Ground COGIC. He also served as an Evangelist, Chief Adjutant to Bishop R. Dixon, and State President for YPWW. Dr. Brisbane earned a Bachelor's Degree and was bestowed an honorary Doctorate from St. Thomas Bible College. He was currently serving on the Board of Directors for Kharacter Kids Christian Academy and One Church one Child.

Dr. Brisbane was a bible scholar; he loved to study the Word of God. He had a vast library of bibles and Christian literature. He was an avid fisherman, loved to play chess, loved his family, enjoyed family dinners, and events. He treated each of his children as individuals, as if they were the only child.

Pastor Dwight Brisbane departed this life on Friday, December 30, 2016. He was preceded in death by his mother and father; sister, Sandra Booker.
