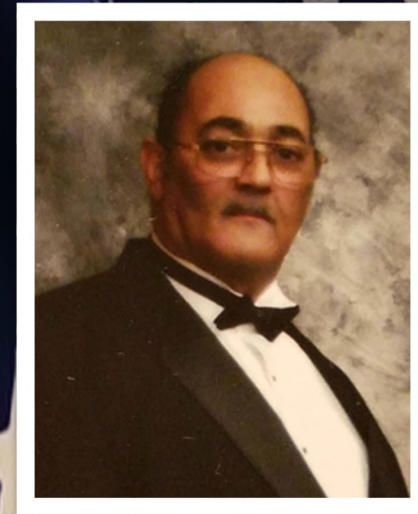

Obituary

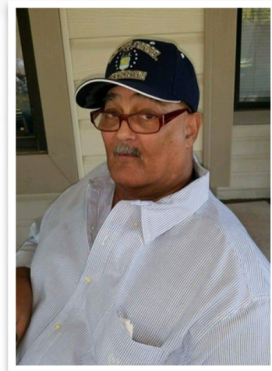
