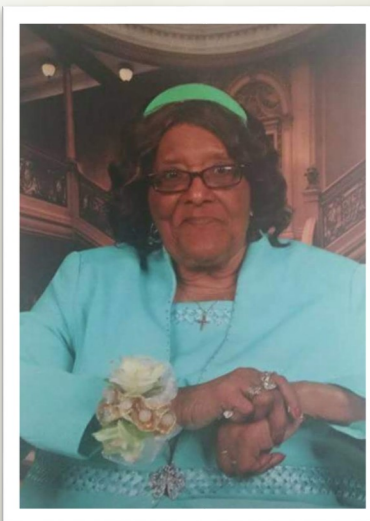
In Loving Memory of Mrs. Tommie Lee Hughes
