

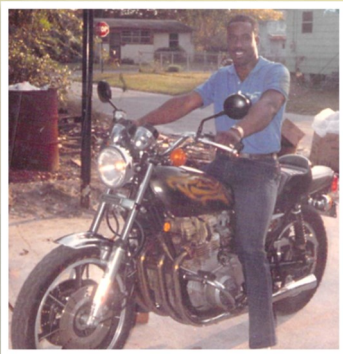
## *Farewell My Friends*
