

Celebrating the Life of Senior Chief Robert Jackson Marshall, Sr.

Robert was born on June 18, 1941 to the late Herman and Verle Marshall in Vallejo, California. He enlisted in the United States Navy on the 27th, of October 1959, and after completing basic training and "A" school, he reported to air transport squadron six, McGuire AFB New Jersey. After decommissioning VR-6 Robert graduated from AE "B" school and reported to VP-7 Naval Air Station in Jacksonville, Florida.

In August 1968 he began an instructor tour with naval air maintenance training detachment 1034 NAS Cecil Field Florida teaching electrical/instrument systems is the A-7 Corsair. In December 1972, he graduated from Pensacola Junior College with an AA degree under the ADCOP program, transferring to HC-3 NAS North Island. He made three westpac cruises aboard USD Camden, USS San Jose, and USS White Plains. Senior Chief Marshall reported to top gun in December 1976 working as the night check maintenance until April 1977 when he became the command career counselor, human relations council advisor, and senior enlisted member of the command training team. He was transferred from active duty to the Fleet Reserve of the US Navy on the 31st of May 1983 after 24 years of service.

Robert later met and married Martine Marshall on May 23, 1998. From this union one daughter was born. He was a loving father and husband who taught all those around him to love without reserve and to live life to the fullest, and he will be missed dearly.

Robert departed this life on Thursday, December 20, 2018. He was preceded in death by his parents, Herman and Verle Marshall.

Robert leaves to cherish his memories a loving wife, Martine Marshall; three children, Jodi Gregory Marshall, Robert J. Marshall, Jr. and Jolie J. Marshall; stepdaughter, Josee L. Kapseu; one granddaughter, one grandson, one great grandson and a host of other relatives and friends.
