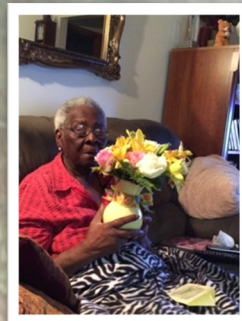
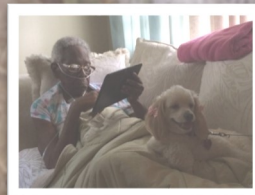




"When I Must Leave You"

On January 24, 2019, God reached down from Heaven in his garden and picked one of His beautiful roses, Marie S. Cuffie and took her to her eternal home.

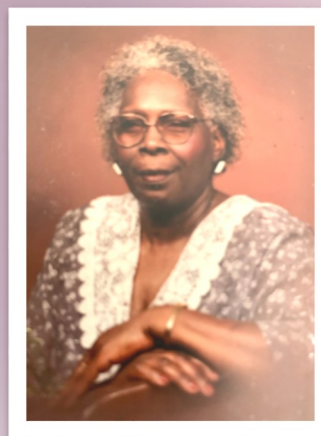
