

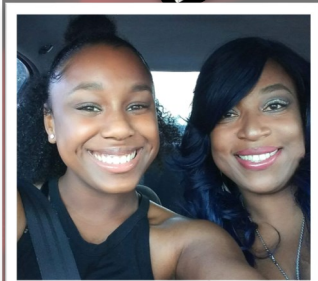

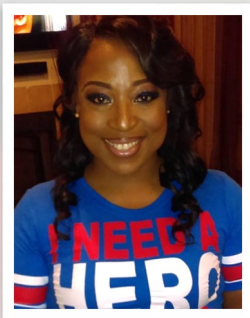

# The Life of Shameka Tramaine Williams



*Shameka* daughter of Johnnie (Mildred) Williams and Margie (Charles) Spaulding was born March 7, 1980 in Jacksonville, Florida. As a military child, she lived in various places throughout her childhood until she moved to Harvey, Louisiana. at the age of 8.
