Gingela was born in Jacksonville, Florida on November 10, 1963 to Mr. and Mrs. Irvin Richardson, Sr. Angela was baptized into the Church of Christ in October 1980. She was educated in Duval County Public Schools, graduating from Jean Ribault High School, Class of 1981. Although initially enrolled as an engineering major at Florida A & M University, her undeniable musical talents and interests led Angela to change course in order to pursue a degree in Music Education. While working towards earning her bachelor's degree, Angela pledged Alpha Kappa Alpha Inc. Sorority and explored the full range of her creative talents through participation in the Playmakers Guild, FAMU Connection, National Association for Music Education (NAMFC), and Choir Psi Phi. The FAMU community experienced Angela's beautiful vocal tones through her singing roles in The Wiz, Bubblin Brown Sugar and many other dramatic and musical productions.

Upon graduating from college, Angela moved to West Palm Beach in 1988, where she continued to enrich lives through music at Palmetto Elementary School and Bear Lakes Middle School.
