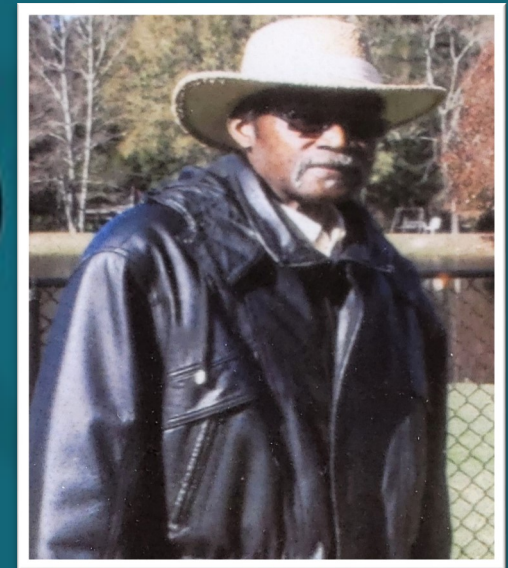

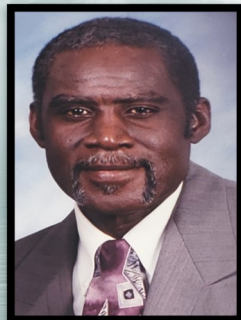
Obituary
