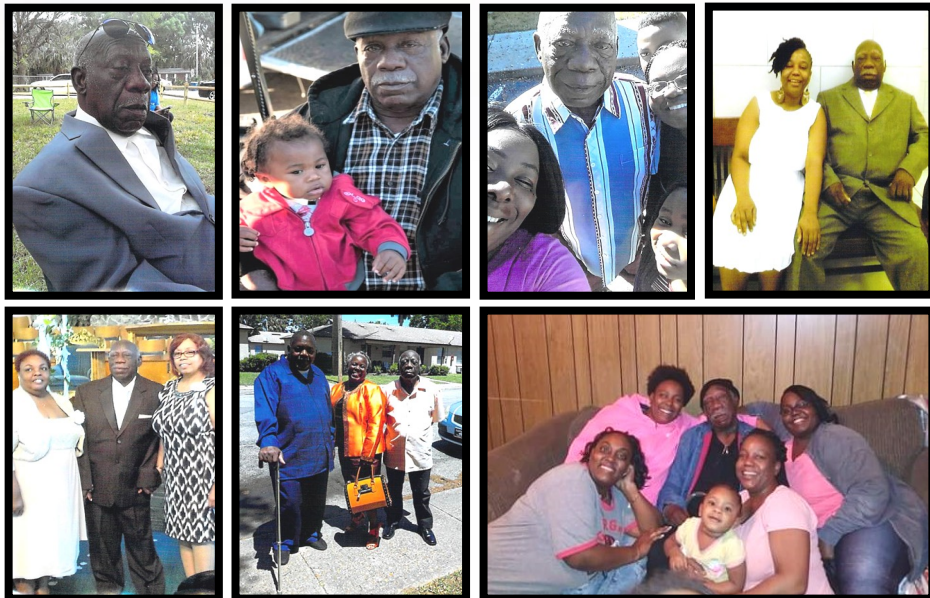
# Obituary
