# Obituary

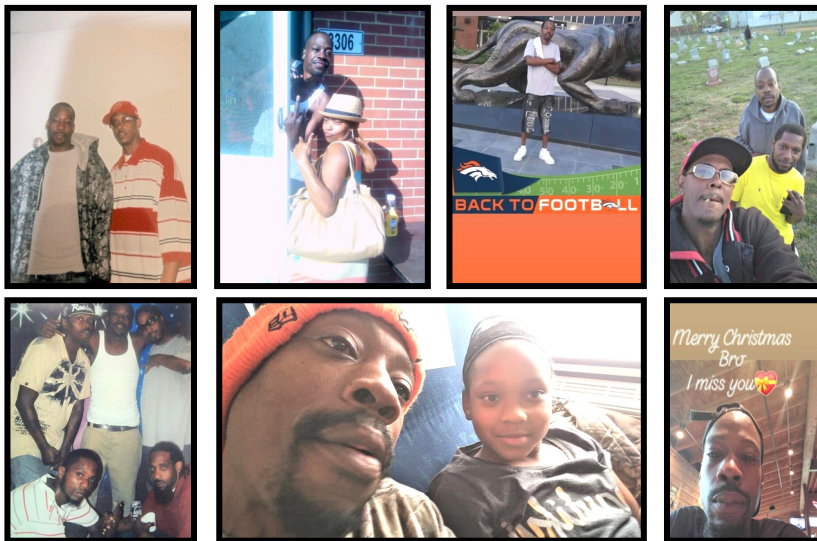
