Lonel was born in Wabasso, Florida on February 13, 1929, his parents were Herman and Theresa Broxton. He confessed Christ at an early age at Saint Paul AME Church in Fort Pierce, Florida. He received his education through the Indian River School District. Lonel then served over twenty (20) years in the United States Navy. His service to the country covered three major conflicts, World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. During his service, he was decorated with the Navy Occupation Award, the Victory Medal for WW2, and four Good Conduct Medals. While stationed in Guantanamo Bay Cuba, Lonel met and married the love of his life, Marina Esther Puig Ramos. To this marriage four beautiful daughters were born: Thereza, Herlinda, Said, and Amada.

After retiring from military service, Mr. Broxton worked many years in law enforcement as a Constable and later Sheriff in Saint Lucie County, Florida. Mr. Broxton later took up trucking and in 1975 relocated the family from Florida to Austin, Texas where they resided for many years. In 1995, Lonel and Marina relocated back to Lake City, Florida where Mr. Broxton continued his truck driving career for Suddath Relocation Van Lines out of Jacksonville, Florida.

Lonel went to his heavenly home on Saturday, January 2, 2021, and was preceded in death by his parents, Herman and Theresa Broxton; brother, Joseph Broxton; and sisters, Hermena Broxton-Webb and Minnie Broxton-McCrary.

Lonel is survived by his wife, Marina Broxton; four daughters, Thereza E. Broxton-Okorocho, Herlinda Ramos-Leach, Said E. Broxton-Chang, and Amada N.
