He attended Longbranch Elementary school and graduated from Andrew Jackson Senior High School in 1975.

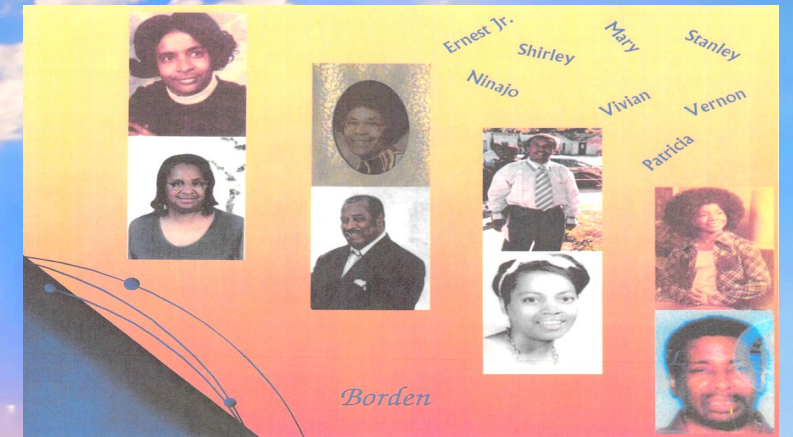
For over 15 years, he was a long-standing, well respected and loved member of The International Longshoremens' Association, Local (1408) of Jacksonville, Florida.
