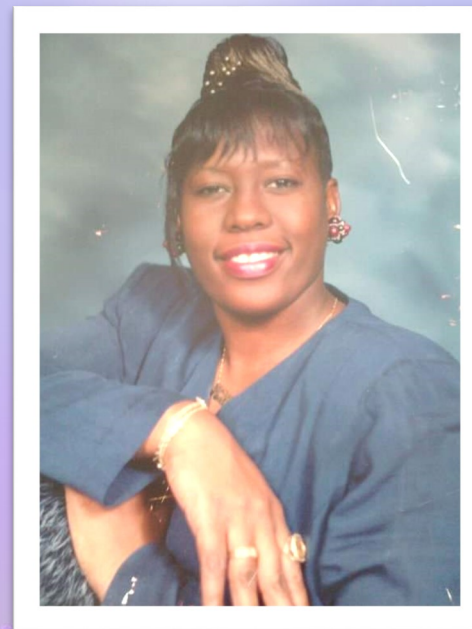

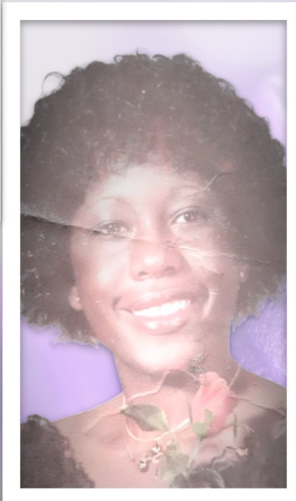
Life Reflection
