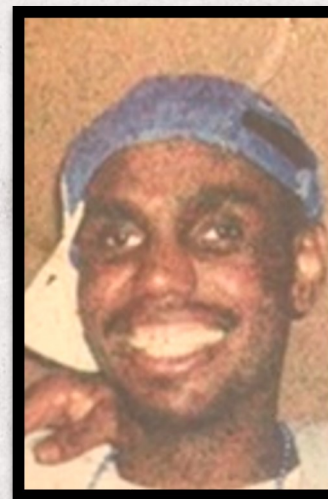

## Obituary

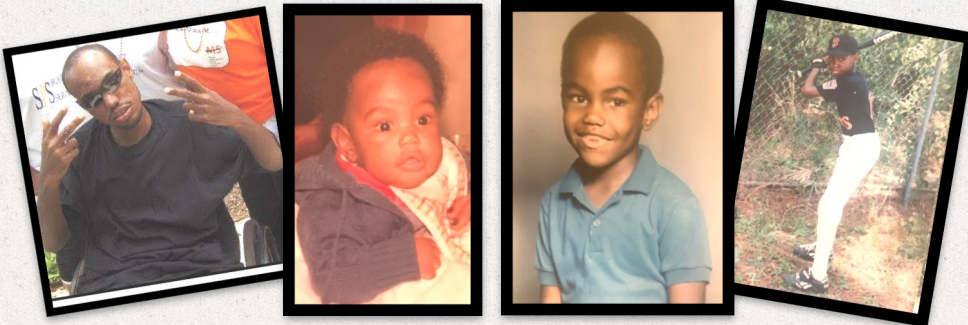
