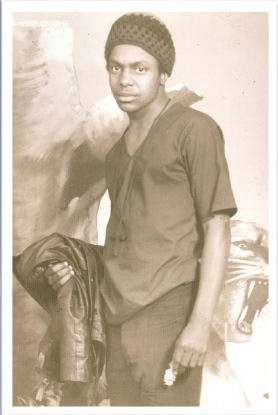

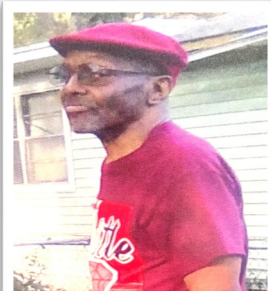
# Obituary
