

Obituary



Solomon Fisher Jr., age 90, on May 13, 2022, soul was called to its final eternal resting place. He was born October 14, 1931, to the late Solomon Fisher Sr. and Essie Mae Fisher. He was the youngest of three children. He was preceded in death by his wife, Polly Mae Fisher; two sons, Michael Fisher and Michael Gordon; one daughter, Connie Freeman from Brooklyn, NY; and brother, Willie Fisher from Brunswick, GA.

He enlisted in the United States Army November 14, 1955 and received an honorable discharge October 23, 1957. The United States Navy employed him as a Civil Service Employee for more than 32 years; he retired September 01, 1995, culminating more than 34 years of faithful and devoted federal government service to the United States of America. Solomon Fisher Jr. was the first Black American to paint the new F/A-18s Fighter Boomer Aircraft.
