So much beauty, grace, and love.*

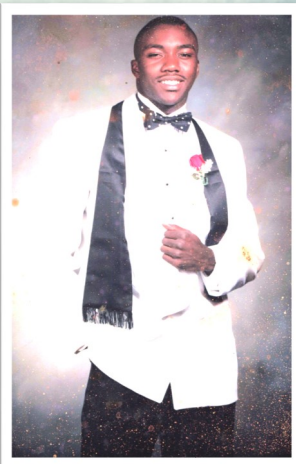
*You touched our hearts in so many ways
