But with the love in our hearts You walk with us forever.*

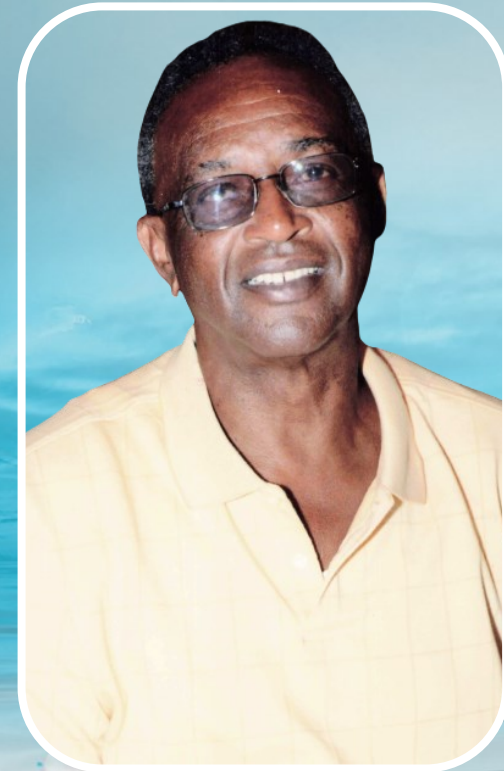
