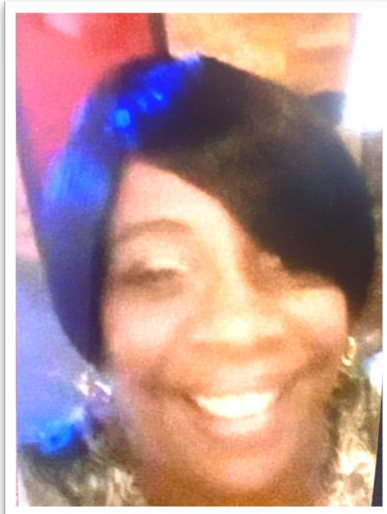
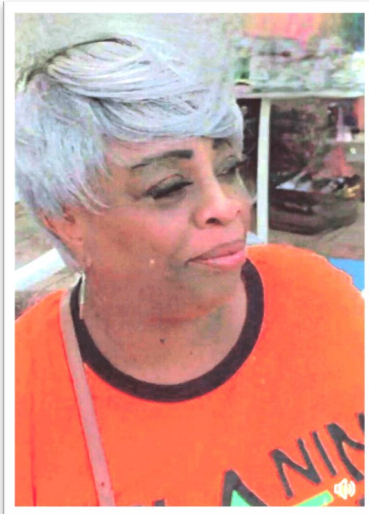
Obituary
