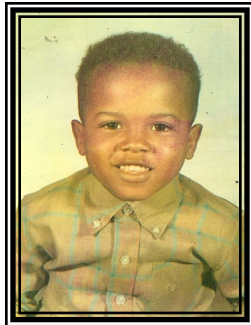

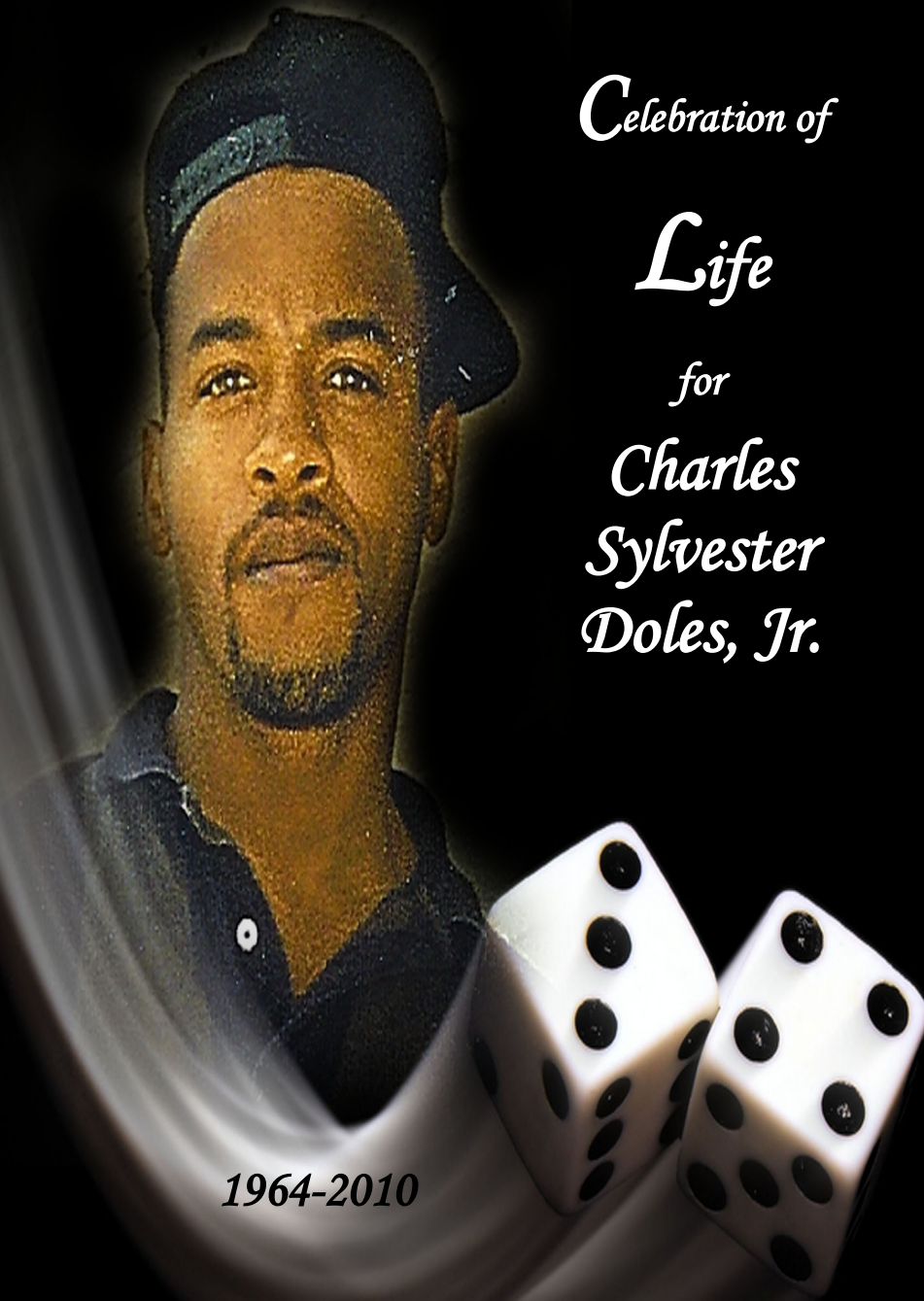

LIFE REFLECTIONS

Charles Sylvester Doles, Jr. was born in Jacksonville, Florida on November 9, 1964 to Charles and Mary Doles. His mother moved to Logan Street (off Tyler) when he was very young, and he put his roots down in that neighborhood early. He managed to win the hearts of almost everyone in the entire community; young and old; men and women. During his lifetime he became the father of 8 children: Tenisha Lamar (22), Dominique Lloyd (18), Michael Jones (17), Victoria Pinkney (17), Devonte Lloyd (16), Charles Javon Doles (16), Nevaeh Barrett (5), Freddie Barrett (4), and "like a son"- Florentino Barret (7). Yes, Charles loved the ladies; and the ladies loved him back.

"Charles Doe" passed away suddenly and unexpectedly on Friday, August 27, 2010 due to untreated high blood pressure that caused him to have a brain stroke. He was an organ donor. He was preceded in death by his father, mother, 1 brother (Charles Doles, Jr.), a baby sister (Darlene Doles), and a beloved sister (Charlotte Doles, who has been a missing person since June 19, 1983. She was 19 years old).
